

## INTRODUCTION

# Genesis

- 1. With View to motivate and prepare the young boys to join the Defence Services in the Officer Cadre, a committee was formed under the chairmanship of Lt Gen SPP Thorat, (Retd), Kirti Chakra, Padmashree, DSO, D'Lit.
- 2.On the recommendations by this committee the unique Services Preparatory Institute was established at Aurangabad in 1977 with the aim of preparing boys physically, mentally and academically for entry into the National Defence Academy, (NDA) Khadakwasla
- 3.The Institute provides personalized coaching for UPSC (NDA) written entrance examination. The curriculum at SPI is formulated in such a way that, the cadets are prepared for the written examination (UPSC) and to appear for the Services Selection Board (SSB) interviews.

# Aim of SPI

4. To encourage the youth of Maharashtra to join the Armed Forces as officers.

# **Organization**

- 5. The Institute works under General Administration Department (Desk-28) of Mantralaya.
- 6.SPI is headed by a Director who is a retired Armed Forces Officer of the rank of Lt Colonel and above or equivalent ranks of Indian Navy and Indian Air Force.
- 7.A Governing Body (GB) is appointed by the Government to oversee functioning of SPI.
- 8.SPI has a dedicated and experienced staff most of whom are retired personnel from the Armed Forces, to look after training, discipline and welfare of the cadets all the time. A homely and caring atmosphere is also ensured.

9.The SPI is located at Sector N-12, CIDCO, Chhatrapati Sambhajinagar in a well established campus of 10 acres.

## **CHARTER OF AN SPI CADET**

- 1. Aim of a Cadet. To be a GOOD military leader in the FASTEST time frame by FAIR and SQUARE means.
- 2. Rules and Regulation. While in SPI, cadets are subject to certain rules and regulations. Few of the important ones are highlighted in this section for your information. As discipline is very important, it is recommended that the cadet be advised to strictly follow these rules during his stay at the SPI to ensure fruitful and productive training. The under mentioned do's and don'ts must be observed.

#### Do's.

- (a) Do be punctual for all activities like, PT, games, classes, parades, mess etc.
- (b) Do be smartly dressed at all times for all activities in the prescribed dress code.
- (c) Do keep all your personal possessions neat and tidy at all times.
- (d) Do be courteous to your seniors and superiors at the SPI.
- (e) Do maintain the highest standard of honesty and integrity.

#### 4. Don'ts.

- (a) Do not leave the SPI premises without proper permission.
- (b) Do not involve in smoking, drinking alcohol and consuming drugs, or have any such items in your possession.
- (c) Do not keep excess cash, jewellery, cell phones, any electronic or electrical appliances.
- (d) Do not possess any personal weapons, i.e.guns, fire arms knife etc.
- (e) Do not get tattoo on your body.

## 5. It would help your son to settle down, if he practices the following simple activities before joining:

- (a) Stitching of buttons and minor repairing of his clothes.
- (b) Polishing his shoes (leather and canvas).
- (c) Washing his under garments, socks and handkerchief.
- (d) Making his bed.
- (e) Keeping his clothes and personal effects neatly in his cupboard.
- (f) Keeping track of all his personal possessions.
- (g) Making a dhobi list and checking returns accurately.
- (h) Filling bank withdrawal form and maintaining his pocket money account.
- (j) Covering all textbooks and note books with laminated brown paper.
- (k) Labeling his possessions for identification.

# TRAINING AT SPI

#### Aim of a Cadet

1. To be a GOOD military leader in the FASTEST timeframe by FAIR and SQUARE means.

#### **Our Mission**

- 2. Devote all efforts to impart such training that the above aim is achieved. Our philosophy behind the training is:-
  - (a) Focused and goal oriented approach.
  - (b) Easily attainable targets to start with.
  - (c) Gradual increase in the intensity in a scientific manner.
  - (d) Develop officer like qualities through practical tasks.
  - (e) Build a very strong physical and mental core.
  - (f) Instill high standards of honesty, integrity and loyalty.

#### Academics

- 3. Our major emphasis is on academics.
- 4. The cadets are admitted at school / junior college facility in Aurangabad, where they study in XI and XII class in the Science stream which includes the following subjects :-
  - ●Engish
     ●Physics
     ●Chemistry
     ●Maths
     ●Biology or Electronics
- 5. They are required to maintain their academic performance of minimum 60% marks in all SPI and College examinations, to retain their candidature at the SPI.





#### **UPSC (NDA) Entrance Examination and SSB Interview**


- A special orientation for the subjects of UPSC (NDA) entrance examination is given to the cadets by experienced faculty before and after the college hours. Emphasis is also laid on improving their power of expression in English.
- 7. The cadets are given practice in self expression by arranging Lectures, Debates, Quiz Competitions, Group Discussions and Outdoor Excursions. These activities develop their self confidence and bring out the hidden talents.
- 8. The curriculum is so structured that cadets are automatically prepared to face the SSB Interview.
- The minimum educational qualification for admission to NDA is XII standard. Each cadet gets
  minimum of two chances to appear in the UPSC (NDA) entrance examination while he is at
  SPI in September and April, in the second year at SPI.

#### Physical Training & Games

- 10. The aim is to ensure that cadets are in good physical condition to undertake the rigours of training at NDA.
- (a) All cadets will have to participate in physical training in the morning and games in the evening.
- (b) The SPI provides facilities for Foot Ball, Volley Ball, Hand Ball, Basket Ball, Hockey, Athletics, Cross Country, Boxing and Obstacles Course.
- (c) Inter-section competitions for all above games are organised.

# **Development of Moral Fibre**

- 11. <u>Motivation and Orientation to the Armed Forces</u>. Motivation is of utmost importance. The cadets are given exposure to life in the Armed Forces through a series of lectures, training films and visits to various Defence establishments.
- 12. <u>Discipline.</u> Cadets are expected to follow all orders and instructions meticulously.
- 13. <u>Development of Leadership Qualities</u> The cadets are introduced to various aspects of leadership, by participation in the routine activities of the institute.
- 14. Communication & Allied Skills It is mandatory for all cadets to communicate in English at all times. Emphasis is laid on extempore speech and group discussions.






## **Preparation for SSB**

- 15. Complete infrastructure for SSB training has been developed on the campus. It includes Individual Obstacles, Group Obstacles, Command Tasks and Group Tasks. Preparation for SSB will include the following:-
  - (a) Group Tasks. (b) Group Discussions and Lecturettes. (b) Personality Development.
  - (d) Interview Techniques. (e) Individual and Group Obstacles. (f) Psychological Tests.
  - (g) Intelligence Tests.

17. On Sundays SPI conducts extra UPSC classes in the morning. The cadets are given 'Out Pass' in the afternoon from 1400h to 1800h on Sundays.





### **Admission Eligibility**

- Domicile. Domicile of Maharashtra State. Every cadet is required to submit the domicile certificate issued by the government to confirm his candidature.
- 2. Age Limit, Sex, and Marital Status. Only unmarried male candidates can apply. The Candidate must be born within the dates mentioned in the advertisement published every year.
- 3. Educational Qualifications.
  - (a) Candidates studying in 10th standard of State/CBSE/ICSE or equivalent pattern with English, Physics, Chemistry (or General Science) and Mathematics as subjects are eligible to appear for the SPI Entrance Examination.
  - (b) They must secure minimum 60% marks in 10th Examination.
  - (c) The candidate should have also secured minimum of 60% marks in VII, VIII and IX st. examinations.
- Physical Standards. The Candidate should have the following 'physical standards' at the time
  of joining SPI. This list is not exhaustive, but it is a guideline. The cadet must be medically fit,
  to join the defence academies.

(a) Height: 157 cms(b) Weight: 43 Kg.

- (c) Chest: Without expansion: 74 cms expansion: 5 cm (minimum) for Boys
- (d) Eye sight: 6/6 in a distant vision chart with better eye and 6/9 in worse eye. Myopia less that 2.0D and hypermetropia less than 2.0D Including Astigmatism. A candidate must have good binocular vision. Candidate should not be night blind and colour blind and should be able to recognise red and green colours.
- 5. Selected candidates will have to produce a "Medical Fitness Certificate" signed by a qualified Registered Medical Practitioner at the time of joining. Separate medical test will be conducted at SPI for candidates within first few days after joining. Those who are declared 'Fit' by this panel will only continue at SPI.

6. Now, you can submit SPI Application Form Online only. Click on the tab "Online Application Form" on the Home Page of our website and follow the instructions.





# **Admission Procedure: Written Test and Interview**

Admission to SPI is through Written Test and Interview. Both will be conducted in English only.

#### **Scheme of Written Test**

- The written test will be conducted every year at various centres. Exact dates and place will be intimated on the website <u>www.spiaurangabad.com</u>
- 2. A single question paper in English will comprise of 150 questions in two parts.
- 3. Each question is for 4 marks. Total maximum marks are 600. Time allotted is 3 hrs.
- 4. The first part will be of Mathematics portion having 75 questions and the second part will be of General Ability portion having 75 questions.
- 5. The question paper will be of Multiple Choice Questions Format (MCQ), wherein, under each question, four suggested answers will be given. Candidate has to choose one which is the most appropriate and fill on the OMR sheet provided.
- 6. Every correct answer will be awarded (+) 4 marks and every wrong answer will be awarded (-1) mark. That means the exam will have negative marking system wherein for every wrong answer 1 mark will be deducted. No (+) or (-) marks will be given to the questions that are not attempted.
- 7. The General Ability paper will include questions on English, Science, Social Science/Social Studies, General Knowledge, Current Affairs and logical reasoning. The questions for English will include grammar, comprehension, error correction, synonym-antonym etc.
- 8. The paper will be set from the 8th to 10th Class syllabus of State Board/CBSE/ICSE boards. Apart from this a few questions on general knowledge, current affairs, mental ability may also be asked.
- 9. The Results will be uploaded on the website of the Institute.





#### Interview

- 8. The Candidates who qualify in the written test will be interviewed by the Interviewing Board/Selection Committee. Interviews will be conducted at Pune and / or Chhatrapati Sambhajinagar. It is based on General Intelligence, Personality Test and General Awareness of the candidate and knowledge about the current affairs. The interview is conducted in English and the candidates are expected to communicate in simple English.
- 9. Candidate should bring original copies of annual examination results of 7th,8th,9th and 10th board results (in case the interviews are held after the board results) along with the certificates of other achievements at the time of the interview. Final Merit list will be uploaded on the website

## **RESULT & STEPS THERE AFTER**

#### Selection and Joining SPI

10. Based on the results the Entrance Examination conducted at various Examination Centers and the Interviews, a consolidated overall merits list will be prepared including a waiting list. It will be uploaded on the SPI website. The detailed "Joining Instructions" will be sent to all selected candidates by email. The first term of the new course will normally commence in the 1st/2nd week of June

#### **Academic Terms & Vacations**

- 11. Academic year is divided in two terms viz first term and second term. At the end of the first term, vacations are granted during Diwali in the month Oct/Nov. At the end of second term vacations are granted during summers, most likely during the month of April/May.
- 12. <u>Leave</u>.- There are four types of leave at SPI.- summer break, winter break, sick leave and leave on compassionate grounds (on death of an immediate family member or a blood relation). No other type of leave is granted to a cadet.

# **Discipline & Adhering to the Daily Routine**

13. Military form of discipline is expected to be maintained at SPI all the time and in all activities. Emphasis is given that the cadet maintains a high standard of personal turn-out and conduct in and outside the campus. Any act of indiscipline is dealt with strictly. An agreement to this effect is executed and signed by the parents/guardians of the cadet at the time of joining. For issues related to ragging please refer to paragraph 2(c) under heading Withdrawal under section Joining SPI.





# **Joining SPI**

#### **Fee Structure**

- 1. <u>Boarding Charges</u>. A sum, as decided by the Govt. of Maharashtra from time to time, is charged for six months in advance towords the boarding charges. It is required to be paid at the beginning of each term. At present it is Rs.3000/- per month.
- 2. <u>Security Deposit</u>. An amount of Rs.3000/- (Rs.1500/-in case of SC/ST candidates) is collected at the time of joining. It will be refunded only if cadet joins any of the Defense Academies at any stage in life.
- 3. <u>College Fees</u>. College fees (11th & 12th class) and other charges as decided by the college from time to time will be paid by the parents / guardians through SPI only.
- **4.** <u>Cadet Expenditure</u> . Apart from these the cadets have to pay additional money for their Kit, training visits, training aids, barber and washer man charges, news papers & periodical charges, etc.
- **5.** <u>Penalty Clause</u>. In case a cadet leaves SPI after joining, then the complete fees once paid WILL NOT be refunded. In addition he will be required to pay penalty to be decided later, at the time of his departure.

#### **Withdrawal**

- 6. The Director, SPI has the authority to rusticate any cadet and withdraw his name from the roll on any of the following grounds:
- (a) Remains ill for a period of 56 days (considered physically unfit to carry on with the daily routine of the institute).
- (b) Become medically unfit or is declared to be medically unfit by medical pane of SPI. This includes only false information provided during the joining procedure or later.
- (c) Involves in ragging activities and/or found harmful for other cadets in the hostel.(Orders of the Honorable Supreme Court dated 16th Oct 2000 & Maharashtra Prohibition of Ragging ACT, 1999 amended from time to time will be implemented.)
- (d) Consistently fails to secure minimum 60% marks in SPI or the School tests/examinations, or fails more than three times in any of the PT tests.
- (e) Fails to maintain SPI discipline.
- (f) If Boarding Charges, Fees and other dues are not paid in time by the parents.
- (g) Any other reason, as deemed fit.
